The closing date here is the 31<sup>st</sup> of August. Members vote on the films in September which not only gives us the two members' awards but also helps to decide which films will be included in our Annual Show in October. **This time the Committee have decided that films previously entered for the members vote but not included in previous Annual Shows can be entered this year for this year's Show (but not the Competition).** Only 3 films per member rules still applies and only 2 films per member will be seen at the Show.
